5th T-CREPE NEWSLETTER November 2021 - April 2022

T-Crepe (Textile Engineering for Co-Creation Paradigms in Education) is a 3-year Erasmus+ project that started in November 2019. The following text is about the project's activities during November 2021 and April 2022.

3rd Training Workshop – November 2021

On **2-6 November 2021** NKUA and UNIWA universities organized the 3rd Training Workshop of T-CREPE focusing on “ICT tools in Education and Business”. It was a multi-themed dense event that involved 1 Keynote Speech, 3 workshops, 4 roundtables and 4 interactive sessions. The 72 participants came from diverse backgrounds and fields, i.e. lecturers, researchers, textile companies and university students from 5 universities, who worked together and exchanged their experiences and views on textile engineering, co-creation and ICT tools.



Every day the productive and intense work was followed by cultural and social events in the city of Athens including a visit to Acropolis, a visit to the BlueCycle circular economy Greek company, a visit to the Greek Textile Museum, and a classical music concert.

External Partners are using our planet platform

In the 1st semester of the Academic Year 2021-2022, 3 external universities (not members of the T-CREPE consortium) used the co-creation planet in 4 courses. University of Aegean in Greece used the

planet in their Bachelor course “Integrated Product Design and Innovation” with 24 students. ESITH University in Morocco used the planet in the Bachelor course “Eco-design, sustainable development and performance” with 10 students. IUE university in Turkey used the planet in the Bachelor courses “Materials for Industrial Design” with 16 students and “Interaction Design Fundamentals” with 18 students. The lecturers of these courses, after receiving training from the T-CREPE researchers, they designed 4 new ChoiCo games that were added into the planet. Additionally, three more courses were implemented during this semester in UGent-Belgium and UNIWA-Greece with 80 students in total.
